

How to Access Verify through GOV.UK Services

The below services are currently available to be used with Government UK Verify:

- [Get a State Pension statement](#), with the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP)
- [Sign in to your personal tax account](#), with Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC)
- [View or share your driving licence information](#), with the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA)
- [Apply for Universal Credit](#) (DWP)
- [Claim for redundancy and monies owed](#), with the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills (BIS)
- [Sign in and file your Self Assessment tax return](#) (HMRC)
- [Update your rural payments details](#), with the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra)

If a citizen is looking to sign up with Verify to use these services, they can follow the below routes to access them:

Get a State Pension statement, with the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP)

- Click on 'Apply Online'

You can [apply online](#). The online service is currently in 'beta' - it's being tested and improved.

You can also get a forecast of how much you could get when you reach State Pension age and find out how to increase this amount.

- Then click '...you can also sign in using GOV.UK verify...'

You need to confirm your identity

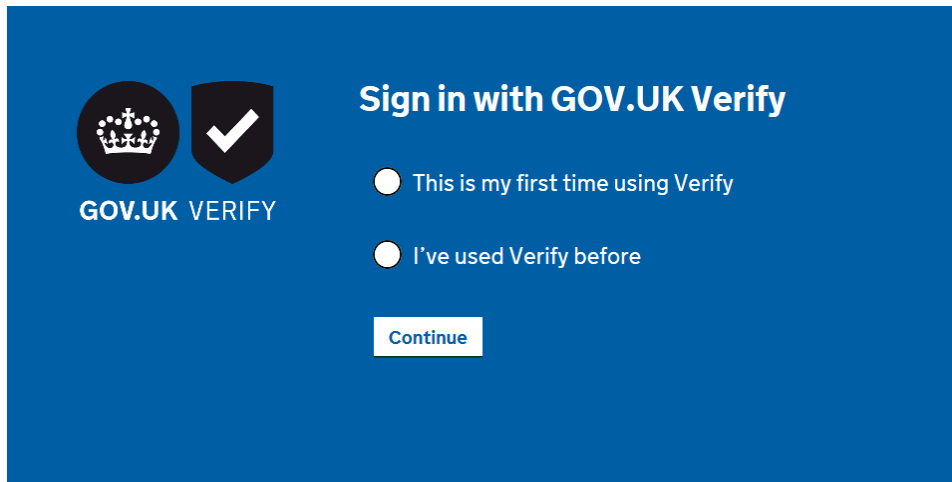
You can sign in using the Government Gateway. You may need to answer a few questions – they'll be based on things HMRC already know about you. You can then access other HMRC services securely.

You can also [sign in using GOV.UK Verify](#). If you have not used GOV.UK Verify before, it will take you about 10 minutes to get set up. You can access other government services securely wherever you see the GOV.UK Verify logo.



- The citizen is then directed straight to the sign-in page.



Sign in to your personal tax account, with Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC)

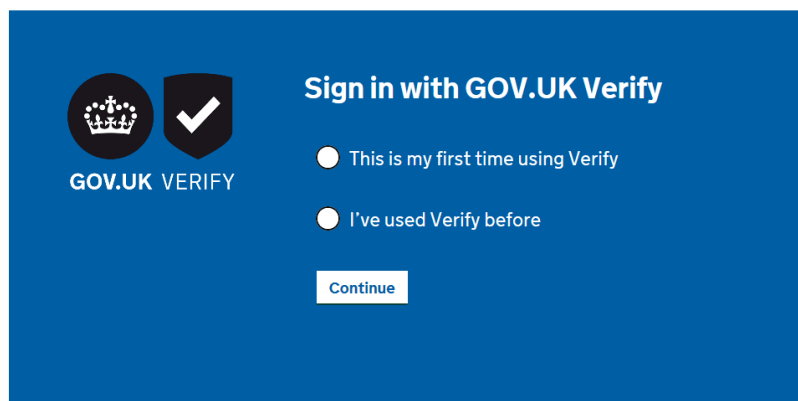
- Click '...you can also sign in using GOV.UK verify...'

For security, you may need to answer a few additional questions – they'll be based on things HMRC already know about you.

You can also [sign in using GOV.UK Verify](#), but you won't be able to use some services. If you haven't used GOV.UK Verify before, it will take you about 10 minutes to get set up.

This service is just for personal tax - [sign in to HMRC's online services](#) if you want to manage your business tax, eg a tax return for self-employment.

- The citizen is then directed straight to the sign-in page.



View or share your driving licence information, with the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA)

- On this page, simply click 'Other ways to apply'

You can [apply using GOV.UK Verify](#) if you have all of the following:

- a valid UK passport or a photocard driving licence issued in England, Wales or Scotland
- access to information about your bank account or credit cards
- a mobile phone or tablet computer

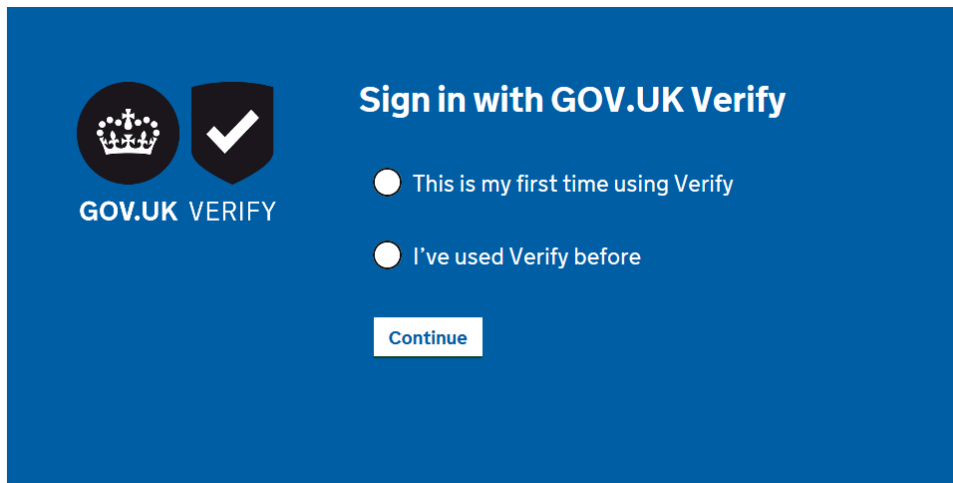
- The citizen then needs to select the tick box for 'I agree to the Redundancy...'. Then they select 'GOV.UK Verify'.

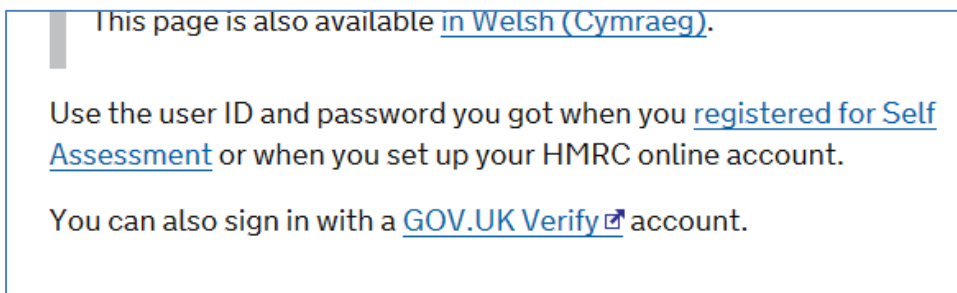
GOV.UK Verify >

- The citizen is then directed straight to the sign-in page.

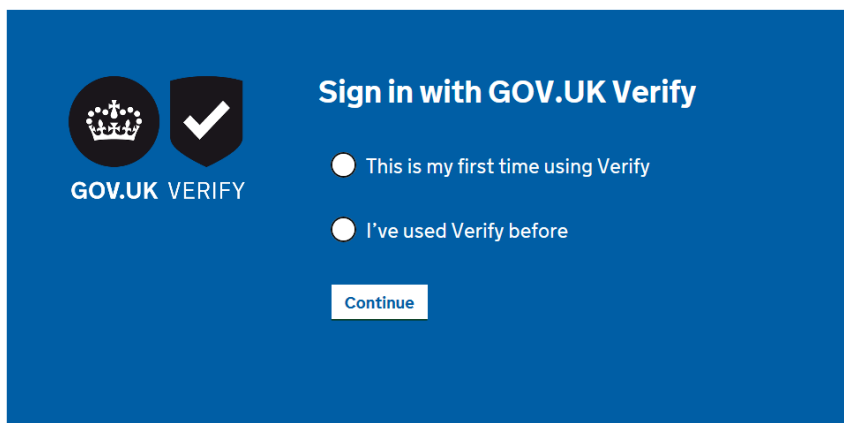


Sign in and file your Self-Assessment tax return (HMRC)

- On this page, the citizen simply needs to click 'You can also sign in with a GOV.UK Verify account':



- The citizen is then directed straight to the sign-in page.



Update your rural payments details, with the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra)

- Click on 'Start Now' as per the below:

- check your registered land parcels and transfer them to another business
- check your Basic Payment Scheme (BPS) entitlements and transfer them to another business

- This will bring the citizen to a page where they next need to select 'Register for Rural Payments':

You'll need a photocard driving licence or passport, and 2 of the following:

- a current account
- a credit card
- a personal loan
- a mortgage
- gas or electricity bills
- a mobile phone contract
- registered to vote


- first and last name


